 the bearer of this Certificate, a subject of *Austria*
 who was interned as a Prisoner of War in Canada at Lethbridge,
 Alta., *and* described for identification as follows:-

Has Canadian papers
 has been discharged from internment subject to the following
 conditions:-

1. That I will not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority.
2. That I will observe the Laws of the Country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemy.
3. That I will report at such place and time as the Officer Commanding Internment Station may decide.
4. *That I will report at the nearest mounted Police station at Bellevue on the first day of each month.*
