1. That he shall not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:
2. That he shall observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:
3. That he shall report at such times and places as the Chief of Police at Belleville, Ont., may direct.

4. *This man given permission to go to Oshawa Ontario to work, and to report to chief constable on his arrival there August 10 1916.*
