who was interned as a prisoner of war in Canada at Fort Henry, Kingston,  
described for identification as follows:—

Age 37, Height 5' <sup>3 3/4</sup> <sub>4 1/2</sub> Weight 150 pounds, Complexion, Fair-Reddish,  
Hair, ~~Red~~ <sup>dark</sup>, Eyes, Blue, Marks. Small depression on right side of nose.

has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

I have permission to and proceed to Milwaukee,  
1. That ~~he shall not~~ leave Canada ~~during the period of hostilities~~  
Wis. U. S. A.  
~~without an exeat issued by competent authority~~

2. That ~~he shall~~ observe the laws of the country, ~~abstain from~~  
from his domicile in the United States he will report  
monthly to the Commandant, Fort Henry, such report being certified  
~~espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to~~  
to by a Magistrate.  
~~give information to or assist the enemy~~

3. That such monies as may be at his credit in the Alien  
Prisoners of War Fund be allowed to so remain until  
the close of the War as Security for the performance  
of the promise above made.
