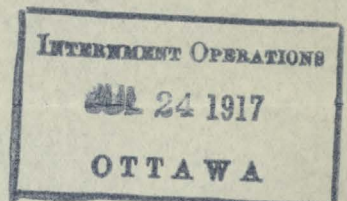
have been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:-

3. That I agree to work for Mr. F. Becker for six months, at current wages.

4. That I shall report as directed by the nearest R. N. W. M. Police Officer.
