INTERMENT OPERATIONS

This is to certify that I, No. 425 Fred Kutybaba (Brandon No. 905)

a subject of Austria

who was interned as a prisoner of war in Canada at Banff, Alta.

described for identification as follows:-

Age 38 years Height 5' 8" Weight 151 lbs.

Complexion Dark Hair Black Eyes Brown.

have been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:-

1. That I will not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:

2. That I will observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:

3. That I will report as directed by the nearest Police Officer to the point at which I am employed.

4. That I will accept employment from Mr. Benjamin Haegeman, SOMERSET, MANITOBA, for a term of at least six months at current wages.

Dated at Banff, Alberta, this Twenty-sixth day of May, 1917.
