2. That ~~he shall~~ observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemy:

3. That I will report to the Chief of Police at Brandon, Manitoba, on fifteenth day of September and fifteenth day of each succeeding month till

4. End of present war.

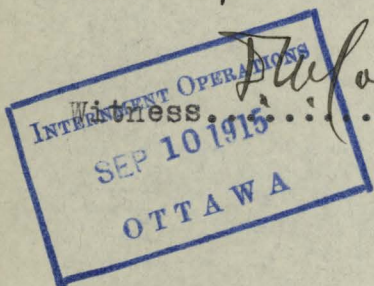
5. That I will stay in the steady employ of Mr John Wilcox, Brandon, Man. till end of present war.
