3. That he shall report to the sergeant in Command of the R. N. W. M. P., Canmore Alta. and at such times and places as he may direct.

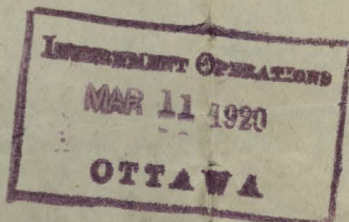
