

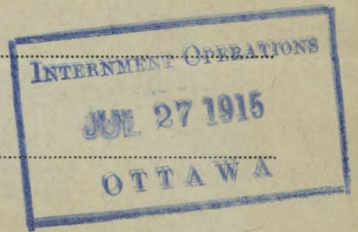

have been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

1. That ~~he shall~~<sup>I will</sup> not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:

2. That ~~he shall~~<sup>I will</sup> observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemy:

3. That I will join my brother upon a homestead in Pruden, Sask., and remain there.

4. That I will report to the postmaster at Kellogg's Postoffice on the first day of August 1915, and to first day of each succeeding month during the period of the present war.

5. My address will be Pruden, Sask.
