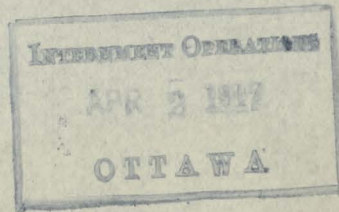
1. That I will not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:
