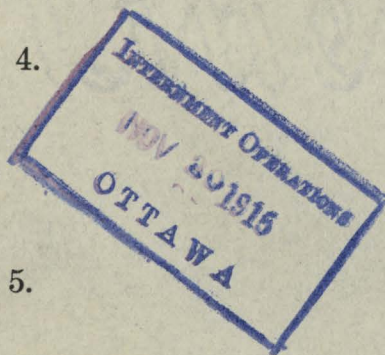
has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—
