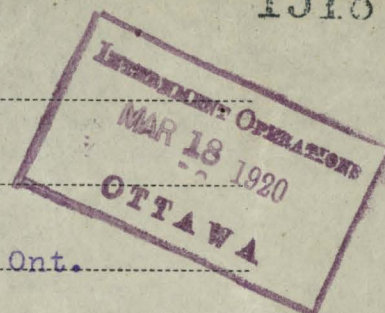

3. That he shall report at such times and places as the Chief of Police at Port Arthur may direct.
