has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

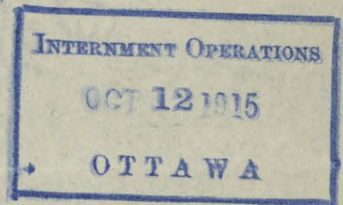
1. That ~~he shall~~^{I will} not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:

3. That I will report to Capt. Davidson, 74 Colony St.,
Winnipeg, at such times and places as he may designate.

4. That I will report for instructions to Capt. H. J. Davidson
74 Colony Street, Wpg., on October 9th 1915.
