3. That I will work in the steady employ of Julian Chobotack, Sec. 2 Sp. 19. B. 3. East St. Julie Manitoba, for year or more.

4. That I will immediately on arrival in Winnipeg, Man. report for further instructions to Capt. H. J. Davidson 7th Colony St.
