3. That I will stay in the steady employment of Mr Andrew Gillespie, of Oak Lake, Man, for a period of Seven Months from the Date of signing this Undertaking.
4. Released on Farmer's Employment Guarantee Scheme to Mr Andrew Gillespie, Oak Lake, Man.
