3. That he shall report as directed by the nearest Police Office

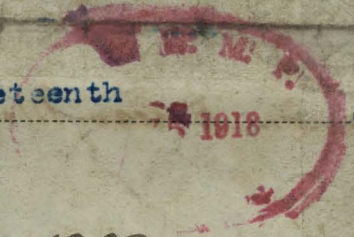
