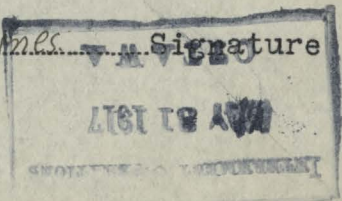
4. That I agree to work for the Dominion Iron Corporation for at least six months, at current wages.
