

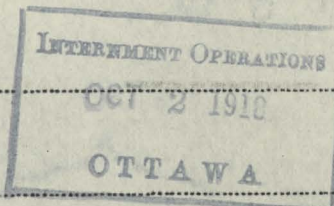

2. That I will observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:

3. That I will report as directed by the Chief of Police at SUDBURY, Ont.

4. That I will agree to work at current rate of wages for at least 6 months for the British America Nickel Corporation, Limited, of NICKELTON, near SUDBURY.
