~~1. That he shall not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an order issued by competent authority~~

1. That he shall observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire.

2. That upon being given permission to proceed to the United States I faithfully promise and undertake not to take up arms against Great Britain during present hostilities.
