2. That he shall observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire;
3. That I undertake to work for the Canadian Pacific R Railway for at least 6 months at current wages.
4. That I undertake to report as directed by the nearest Police Officer to the point of work.
