has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

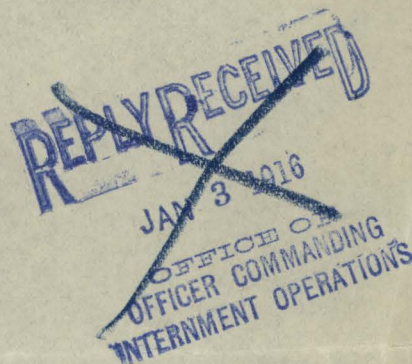
1. That <sup>I will</sup> ~~he shall~~ not leave Canada during the period of hostilities

place as that Officer may decide.
