3. That I will report to Postmaster at  
Pegot, Manitoba, on Fifteenth day of  
September, & Fifteenth day of each

4. subsequent months till end of War.

5. That I will stay in the steady employ of Mr  
Geo. Richards, farmer, Pegot, Man. till end of  
present war.
