has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

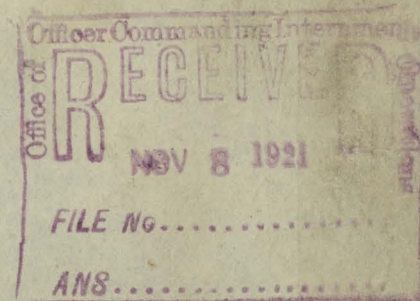
1. That he shall not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:
