has been discharged from internment subject to the following
conditions:-

1. That he shall not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:
2. That he shall observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:
3. That he shall report as directed by the Registrar of Aliens, MONTREAL.
4. That he shall agree to work for at least six months at current wages for Mr. J. Friedman of the Universal Importing Company, MONTREAL.
