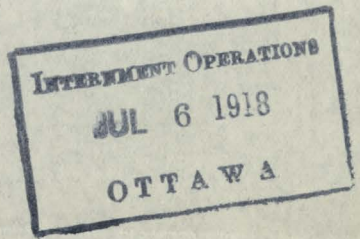

3. That I will report as directed by the Registrar of Aliens, MONTREAL.
