3. That I promise to accept employment from Mr. J.H.
Hughes, Brandon, and to report to the Officer Commanding,
Internment Station, Brandon, at such times and places as
he may direct.

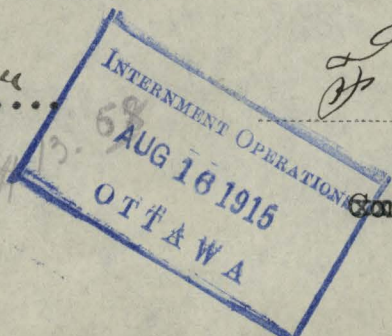
4. That I will report to Capt. D. W. Laleman, at the
Prisoners of War Office, Brandon, on September 1st, and
the first year succeeding my arrival till the end of the
present war.
