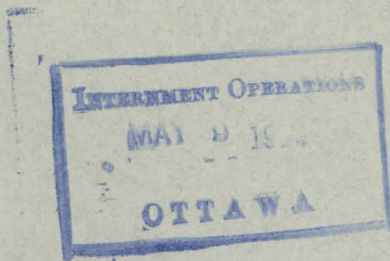

3. That I will report to Major W.E. Date, 172 St. Antoine St., Montreal, Que. at such times and places as that officer may direct.
