2. That I will observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:

3. That <sup>I will</sup> ~~he shall~~ stay in the steady employment of Mr P. J. Mc Kullen, Vanguard, Sask, for a period of seven months, from the date of signing this undertaking

4. That I will report to the Royal North West Mounted Police at Vanguard, Sask, as they shall direct.

5. Released on Farmer's Employment Guarantee Scheme to Mr P. J. Mc Kullen, Vanguard, Sask.
