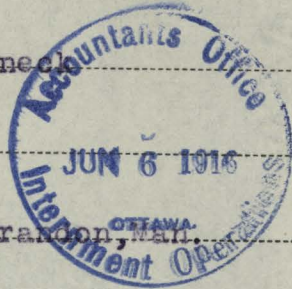


This is to certify that I, Aleckea Wlaineck

1. That I will not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:
2. That I will observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the British Empire:
3. That I will stay in the steady employment of Mr Spira Enick, Rouleau, Sask, for a period of seven months from the date of signing this undertaking.
4. Released on Farmer's Employment Guarantee Scheme to Mr Spira Enick, Rouleau, Sask.
5. That I will report at such times and places as directed by the Commissioner of the Royal North West Mounted Police at Regina, Sask
