has been discharged from internment subject to the following conditions:—

1. That <sup>I will</sup> ~~he shall~~ not leave Canada during the period of hostilities without an exeat issued by competent authority:

2. That <sup>I will</sup> ~~he shall~~ observe the laws of the country, abstain from espionage or any acts or correspondence of a hostile nature or intended to give information to or assist the enemy:

3. That I will report to The Commandant, Internment Station Brandon, at such times and places as that officer may direct.

4. That I will report to Commandant Internment Station Brandon at his office, in Arena, on October 1<sup>st</sup> and the ~~first~~ day of each succeeding day till end of the present war.
5. That I will stay in the steady employ of Mr. John Carran, Brandon, Milkman, till end of war.
