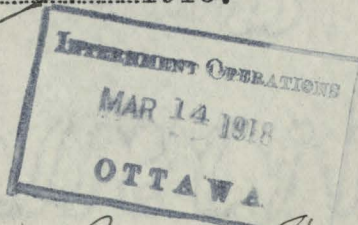

or intended to give information to or assist the enemies of the
British Empire:
3. That he agrees to work for the Dominion Steel Corporation,
SYDNEY, N. S. for at least six months at current wages.
4. That he shall report as directed to Capt. D. A. Noble,
Assistant Provost Marshal, Sydney, N. S.
